



e3 and VSB celebrate commissioning of three new wind turbines at Quellendorf wind farm

Quellendorf, 24 September 2023 - erneuerbare energien europa e3 GmbH and VSB Neue Energien Deutschland GmbH are today celebrating the successful commissioning of three new wind turbines at the Quellendorf wind farm together with invited guests.

During the event, the planning and development teams of e3 and VSB will present the project and go into detail about the most important milestones. In addition, guests and planners will get to talk about the opportunities and challenges in the conversion of the domestic energy supply.

The turbines commissioned to extend the existing Quellendorf wind farm are two Vestas V150 with a capacity of 5.6 MW each and one Vestas V136 with a capacity of 4.2 MW. This corresponds to a total output of 15.4 MW. Including these new additions, the Quellendorf wind farm now comprises 25 wind turbines. The new units will generate around 48 GWh of electricity per year enough to supply around 12,000 four-person households with green electricity on a sustainable basis.

"The expansion of the Quellendorf wind farm is a significant step forward in achieving the regional energy targets," says **Thomas Winkler**, **Managing Director of VSB Neue Energien Deutschland GmbH**.

Jens Schöttler, Managing Director of e3 GmbH, adds: "The Quellendorf wind farm illustrates the potential when project developers, municipalities and land owners work together cooperatively."

Both project developers pay tribute to the region's commitment to the energy transition and underline the crucial role of wind energy in reducing CO₂. They emphasise the importance of making the best possible use of existing resources and continuing the expansion of renewable energy in order to work together to combat advancing global warming.
