

Do not let the energy transition reverse

Wind park planner WSB demonstrates together with thousands of people in Berlin

Dresden, 8 May 2014 – On 10 May 2014 tens of thousands of people will again take to the streets in protest for the energy transition in. So will the WSB corporate group from Dresden. The demands are clear: consequently extend renewable energies, ensure investment security, further enable public participation.

The energy transition is maintained by medium-sized companies, numerous municipalities and a broad public participation. "This social fundament is the basis of our work", says Andreas Dorner, manager of WSB Neue Energien Holding GmbH. „Out of this centre enormous capital expenditures have already been and also will be made for the creation of the decentralized energy supply.
